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Regulated Price Plan (RPP) Self-Declaration Form

Small Business, Multi-Unit Residential Premises and Farms

The Regulated Price Plan (RPP) provides stable, fixed energy pricing, to farm customers; businesses in a Class B Global Adjustment status whose energy consumption is 250,000 kilowatt hours or less annually; and multi-unit complexes who own, or manage, a building that has one meter for multiple residences. The Ontario Energy Board sets the commodity rates for the Regulated Price Plan.

Milton Hydro Distribution Inc. ("Milton Hydro") uses this form to determine a customer's eligibility for Ontario's Electricity Regulated Price Plan. **If your account meets any of the eligibility criteria below, please complete this Regulated Price Plan Self-Declaration Form.** Submission instructions are available at the top of this document.

RPP Eligibility

1. Carry on a business that is a farming business for the purposes of the Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993, and holds a valid registration number assigned under that Act or has had their obligation to file a farming business registration form waived pursuant to an order made under subsection 22(6) of that Act.
2. A business in a Class B Global Adjustment status with electricity consumption of 250,000 kilowatt hours or less annually.
3. Your account relates to: a dwelling, a property within the meaning of the Condominium Act, 1998, a residential complex, within the meaning of the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006, a property that includes one or more housing units and that is owned or leased by a co-operative within the meaning of the Co-operative Corporations Act.

If your account qualifies, please fill in the information below. If you have more than one account that qualifies, list each one separately. If there are units in your building or farm complex that are metered or billed separately from the account referenced, do not include them in the total number of units for this account.

* Qualifying units that, (a) consists of a self-contained room or set of rooms, (b) contains kitchen and bathroom facilities that are for the sole use of the unit, and (c) is occupied and used as a residence. The complex must contain at least two (2) qualifying units AND the number of qualifying units must equal at least 50% of the total number of units within the complex.

Note:

- Eligible RPP customers will be moved to their requested rate option at the start of the next billing date, as charges are on a go forward basis.
- Customers that are RPP eligible automatically eligible for the Ontario Electricity Rebate (OER) which is currently set at 18.9% of the bill subtotal before HST. The Ministry of Energy, Northern Development and Mines periodically adjusts the OER when the OEB updates RPP Rates. Learn more about OER at www.ontario.ca/page/changes-your-electricity-bill.

Acknowledgement

By self-declaring for eligibility, you are also acknowledging that under the OEB Act and Reg. 95/05 that you automatically fall under the prescribed Regulated Price Plan (RPP) fixed rate consumer class, unless you meet the exemption criteria defined in the Act and or regulations for the RPP.

By self-declaring for eligibility, you are acknowledging that your account will automatically be switched to RPP. However, you may leave RPP pricing at any time. If you wish to leave the RPP, you will be billed a Final RPP Settlement Amount, based on information posted by the Ontario Energy Board. A customer may leave RPP pricing by either of the following actions:

1. Opt out of the RPP by signing a contract with a retailer of electricity for commodity supply. If you are currently under a retailer commodity price option, your rate plan will not change through this declaration.
2. Opt out of the RPP by electing to be placed on the Hourly Ontario Electricity Price (HOEP) through written request to Milton Hydro if an interval meter is already installed at your service address. If you wish to explore this option and do not know whether you have an interval meter installed at your service address or if you wish to have one installed, contact Milton Hydro to determine interval meter type and/or local interval meter installation conditions.

By self-declaring for eligibility, you are acknowledging that, the above information is true, correct and complete.

By self-declaring for eligibility, you are acknowledging that, all information submitted in this process may be used by Milton Hydro for the purposes of confirming your eligibility for the RPP.
